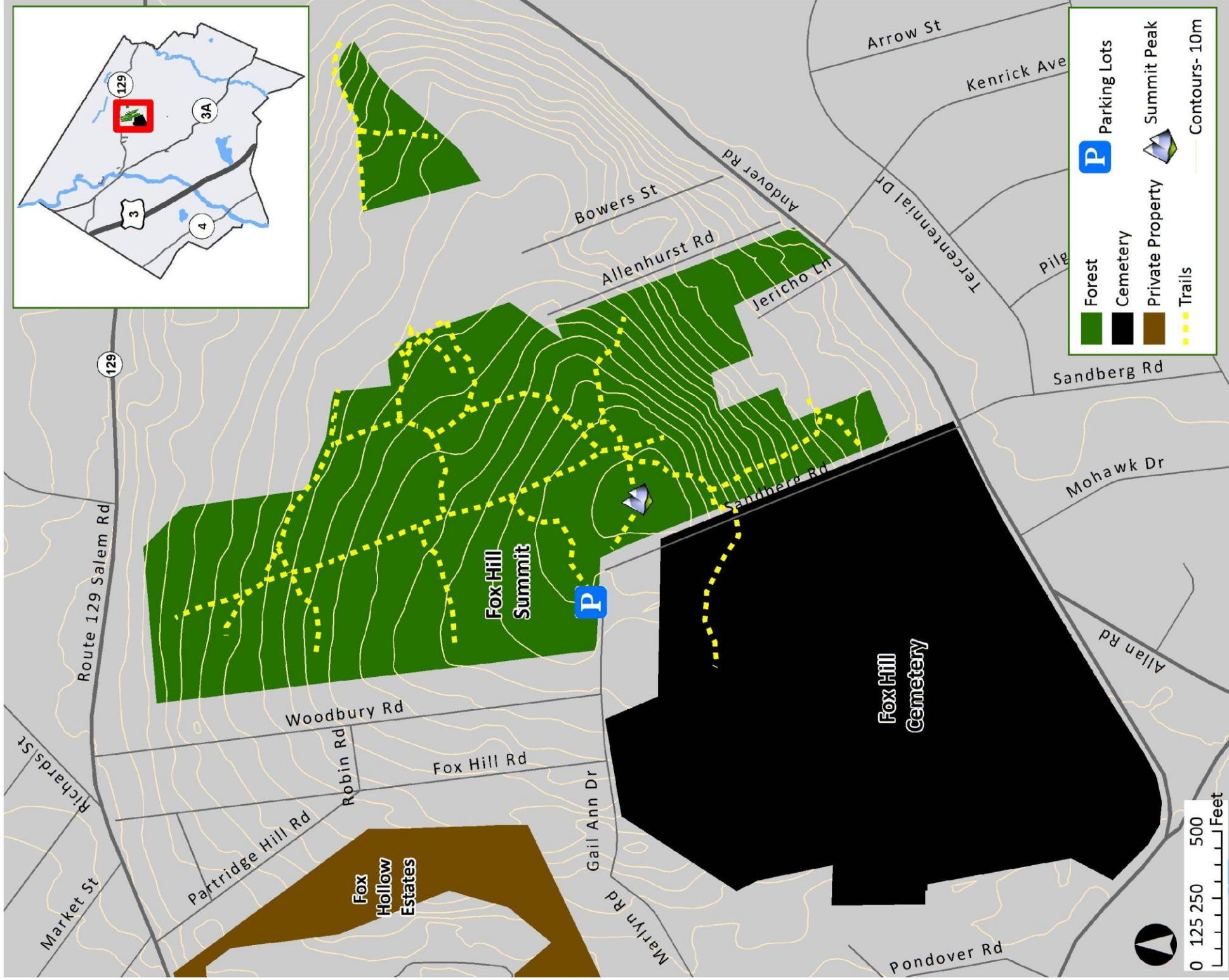

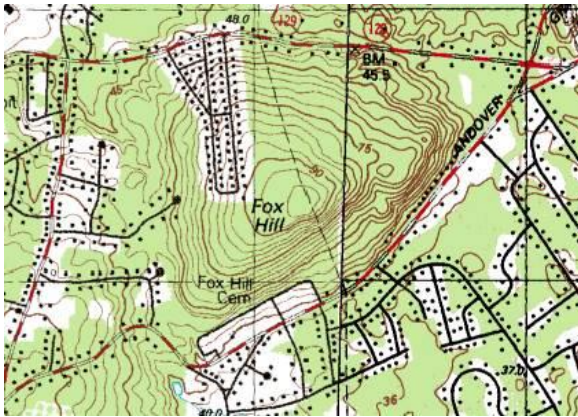

Directions

Fox Hill is not very easily accessible by car.

There is a very small dirt pull off located at the end of Gail Ann Drive on the left that fits 3-4 cars.

However, the best mode of transportation for accessing Fox Hill is via bike or walking.

Fox Hill Summit

Fox Hill Summit is a mountain summit in Middlesex County, located in the northeast region of Billerica. Fox Hill has noted elevations and is one of the two major summits in town. The other summit is Gilson Hill State Forest.

Fox Hill climbs to 315 feet (96.01 meters) above sea level and commands extensive views of the surrounding country. Wachusett and the New Ipswich Mountains can be seen in the distance.
