## Hours and Regulations

- Courts are open in Spring to Fall until 10pm
- Courts open on 1st come- 1st serve basis
  - Unless there is a scheduled recreation program
- Playtime limited to one hour if others are waiting to play
- No Smoking or Alcoholic Beverages
- No Littering
- Dogs must be leashed at all times

## Kindred Conservation Land

Kindred Conservation Land is an 8 acre town owned parcel protected for the preservation of wetlands, wildlife habitat and water quality.

It is located behind Lampson Recreation Complex and is used for passive recreation, including fishing, nature study or quiet relaxation.

Mitchell Pond, which is a town reservoir, is also accessible from Lampson Recreation Complex. This is a great local spot for fishermen; however, a fishing license is required.
